Old Strategies and New Priorities. How Can Historical Research Inform Sustainable Development along the Lower Danube?

Time: 29.09. – 03.10.2023 Place: Belene, Bulgaria

Venue: Hotel Prestige, Hisarlaka Street, 5930 Belene

In 2020, the European Union updated its Strategy for the Danube Region (developed from 2010 onwards) to align with new strategies, notably the European Green Deal. A brief glance at the evolution of the Danube over the last 200 years confirms that goals such as inland navigation, biodiversity, economic disparities, and (flood) risk management had long been on the agenda. Given the unique history of the Lower Danube, this workshop aims to explore whether there is a form of sustainable development that finds a balance between infrastructural development, economic exploitation, nature conservation, and local empowerment.

This workshop is part of the project »Contested Waterway. Governance and Ecology on the Lower Danube, 1800-2018«, funded by the Leibniz Association (2020–2023).
